C.A.P. Meeting Minutes from October 10th, 2016

Meeting was called to order by President Mark McCusker at 7:02pm.

Treasurer Report: The current balance is \$15,101.93. One more scholarship check cleared since the September CAP meeting. At the Senior Night football game, \$360.00 was raised selling seats, cushions and decals. ACE bookkeeping will do the annual review for the cost of \$200.00. Another company was looked into to confirm that ACE is providing very competitive pricing. Danielle moved and Christine seconded that the Treasurer Report be approved. The motion passed unanimously.

Meeting Minutes: The September minutes were reviewed. Lisa moved and Christine seconded that the September minutes be approved. The motion passed unanimously.

Athletic Program: There will be an update to the Code of Conduct policy starting in the fall of 2017. Substance abuse violations will have the same penalty in-season and out-of-season. There will be a 50% participation penalty from the athlete's sport season. If out-of-season, it will carry over to the next season. CAP will again be giving \$1 per athlete to the teams to help with award costs at the banquet. Jay McCulloh, the new boys' basketball coach, was introduced at the meeting. He is already working with the boys in small groups of four.

Committees:

Membership: Since the September meeting, there are 45 new members, which includes three lifetime memberships. This brings in \$980.00 more for membership.

Ed hopes to place another order around the time of the banquets for the winter sports season. The current shipment is slightly delayed due to Hurricane Matthew and the company being located in Miami.
