C.A.P. Meeting Minutes from May 8th, 2017

**Treasurer Report:** The current balance is \$15,367.77. \$8000.00 of the budget is marked for the CAP scholarships. There was a \$75.00 printing fee for the Hall of Fame Dinner programs. Lisa is still waiting on a bill for re-grading the softball field. CAP's portion should be \$250.00. There is approximately \$1200.00-1300.00 left in the Wish List budget. For the spring sport banquets, about \$500-600 gets used for coaches' awards, etc. Marc explained that it is set up for \$1.00 per athlete to go towards coaches' awards for the banquets. Joan moved and Charisse seconded that the Treasurer Report be approved. The motion passed unanimously.

**Meeting Minutes:** The April minutes were reviewed. It was noted to make a spelling correction for Angela's last name, Schultheis. Lisa moved and Joan seconded that the April minutes be approved with the correction. The motion passed unanimously.

**Athletic Program:** The girls track team won the New Balance Invite, formerly known as Observerland Relays. The boys track team got second place. Girls soccer districts will be held at Churchill this year. Belleville is officially in our conference for the 2018-19 schoolyear. We are looking to add two more schools to make it a total of eight teams. Farmington schools are a possibility when they go from three schools to two schools. Meet the Team Night for the next schoolyear will be held on August 16<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Please note location is at FRANKLIN HIGH SCHOOL!!! We will still have tables for each school and for

each team. May 4<sup>th</sup> is official signing day for athletes going on to play at the college level. There will be 28 athletes signing, which is a record number for CHS topping last year's 24 athletes.
