C.A.P. Meeting Minutes from May 4th, 2018

Meeting was called to order by President Mark McCusker at 7:02pm.

Treasurer Report: The balance as of May 13th is \$28,780.33. The balance in PayPal is \$1102.72, mostly from the golf outing and memberships. There was one check for \$75.00 to LPS for the Hall of Fame Dinner printing. Ed motioned and Joan seconded that the Treasurer Report be approved. The motion passed unanimously.

Meeting Minutes: The April minutes were reviewed. A correction needs to be made for the year (2018 instead of 2017). Tony motioned and Ed seconded that the April minutes be approved with the correction. The motion passed unanimously.

Athletic Program: Mark announced that Marc Hage has been named the MIAAA State Athletic Director of the Year for 2019. Marc thanked the parents for their support. CAP was started 17 years ago and has had a great community of parents, students and staff since the beginning.

Outside renovations will start in two weeks. The track will be re-done, the football/soccer field will get new turf, the south end of the field will get a new practice area. The baseball infield will be all turf. The dirt areas will be a brown turf. The softball field will get new turf and will have new dugouts. The concession area will get new asphalt. There will also be new fencing and fieldhouse bleachers.

Bowling has been approved. There will be a male team and a female team for each high school. There was also approval for a unified male and a unified female lacrosse team. This is one team each with players from all three high schools. Bowling coaches have been hired.

With prom now being moved to Friday, different arrangements are being looked at for next year to avoid having prom on the same night as the Conference or Regional Track & Field Meet.

Joan asked about the lighting under the home bleachers. Marc said there is currently a switch but he can look into something that stays lit or is a motion detection light.

Dawn N. shared that the Churchill and Stevenson girls' softball teams raised \$2044.00 to be split between the two schools for their autism programs. The money will go towards improvements in the program's classrooms.

Committees:

Brick Program: Ed has about eight bricks that will be installed. Mark McCusker will take over the brick program if no one else will step forward.

Scholarship: Marc has met with six of the eight winners. He will meet with the other two and then announcements will go out. The winners will attend the golf outing and dinner afterwards.

Decals: Mark is looking into other printers. There will still be new decals in the Fall.

Golf Outing: The golf outing is June 10th. Six more businesses need to be contacted and also any new businesses are welcome to become sponsors or donate items for gift baskets. Hole sponsorship is \$150.00. If a business donates \$150.00 worth of goods, a sign will be made for that business. Contact Charisse if you need the letterhead email to approach a business. There are currently 18 less foursomes than last year. There is usually a last-minute push of teams signing up. Please post about the golf outing on your Facebook page. The cost for dinner only is \$35.00. Golf is \$85.00 per person if you are in a foursome and \$95.00 for a single to join a foursome. These both include the dinner.
