C.A.P. Meeting Minutes from January 14th, 2019

Treasurer Report: The balance as of January 14th is \$27,192.12. The balance in PayPal is \$154.68, which includes memberships and two stadium seats. A check for \$1440.00 was written for more Stadium Seats. Lisa Wood motioned and Mark McConnell seconded that the Treasurer Report be approved as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

Meeting Minutes: The December minutes along with the January minutes will be reviewed at the February meeting.

Athletic Program: Marc spoke in regards to the “Inclusive Sports Programs” that Churchill (along with 8 other teams from the KLAA) participate. The competitions involve Special Needs Athletes along with Student Athletes. Program was originally conceived at Brighton High School (KLAA Member) and received National attention from ESPN. The Inclusive Sports Programs is now offered around the country and continues to grow. In Boys Bowling Noah Campbell had a 299 game today at Thunderbowl in League competition and the Boys team is 8-1 and tied for first place. There will be an open house for incoming Freshman (class of 2023) Student Athletes on January 24th at Churchill.

Committees:

Spirit Wear: Dawn is planning on selling Spirit Wear at the home Boys Basketball Games against Franklin (1/29), and Stevenson (2/12) and also at the incoming Freshman Student Athletes open house next Thursday (1/24).

Bricks: Ed will be placing an order for Bricks in the next week or so, and is planning on receiving and installing by the end of the current School Year.

Old Business:

We are still in need of a Vice President (was brought up and still no takers) for CAP. The Vice President assists with CAP functions as needed and would run CAP meetings in the absence of the President.

Coaches Corner Dinner (now at George Murphy's) will be this coming Sunday January 20th at George Murphy's. Lisa is going to purchase some 50/50 tickets (to sell) for the event. The event runs from 2:00 to 6:00 pm. CAP usually makes around (\$1000) for the day with about half from 50/50 sales and about half donated from proceeds of the business generated that afternoon.

Hall of Fame Dinner is March 13, 2019. Advanced tickets are \$35 each if purchased before March 1st, and \$40 each if purchased after March 1st.
