C.A.P. Meeting Minutes from February 11th, 2019

Meeting was called to order by President Mark McCusker at 7:02pm. – Meeting was moved to area by the Big Red Shed because of the Flag / Dancers rehearsing in the Cafeteria.

Members Present: Mark McCusker, Lisa Hudy, Lisa Wood, Dawn Nowak, Mary Beth Dunn, Mark McConnell, Tony Yaquinto, Cathy Brylinski, Judy Marasco, Liz Parrelly, Mike Brooks, and Sandy Brown.

Treasurer Report: The balance as of February 9th is \$26,968.17. The balance in PayPal is \$319.14, which includes memberships and stadium seats. Mary Beth Dunn inquired about a “Brick Order” that she placed on-line a few weeks ago. Lisa Hudy did not think it has showed up on Pay Pal. Lisa was going to double check the Pay Pal account and Mary Beth was going to make sure that the order posted to her charge card. Mark McConnell motioned and Lisa Wood seconded that the Treasurer Report be approved as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

Meeting Minutes: The January minutes were presented by Mark McCusker who took the minutes at the January Meeting. Danielle Dobar was unable to attend and the December minutes will be reviewed at the March meeting. Lisa Hudy motioned that the January Meeting Minutes be accepted as presented, Cathy Brylinski seconded, the motion passed unanimously.

Athletic Program: Marc Hage was not in attendance. Mark McCusker read the Athletic Program report that Marc had e-mailed earlier in the day. Cap Scholarship announcements have been made during the school-wide morning announcements. Several students have inquired with Marc and he has answered their questions. Due date for the CAP Scholarship Applications is Friday March 29th (the last day before spring break). Application has been updated on the web-site. Cheer are Division and City Champs (again) for the second straight year. No other titles have been decided yet. Athletic Wish List – Marc will be looking for some assistance from CAP in regards to the Competition Gym is getting a makeover (floor and paint). All the Division and Conference Banners on the walls will need to be replaced. Marc has been working with a designer and the total cost will be in the neighborhood of \$3,000-\$4,000. Marc should have his proposal at next Month’s CAP Meeting.

Committees:

Membership: Mike Brooks stopped by and picked up New Memberships from Lisa (Shannon was unable to attend).

Spirit Wear: Dawn sold items at the incoming Freshman Open House and at the Boys Basketball game on January 29th against Franklin. Sales were a little over \$200 at each event. We discussed the dwindling inventory on a few of the items. Mark will talk to McGowan's and find out the cost of a much smaller order to fill in some of the holes. It was thought that we probably could get by for the remainder of the school year. We will discuss at the March meeting when Mark has some pricing to present to the group.

Old Business:

We are still in need of a Vice President (was brought up and still no takers) for CAP. The Vice President assists with CAP functions as needed and would run CAP meetings in the absence of the President. It was discussed that Dawn Nowak has done an incredible job taking over Spirit Wear and helping with other events that she would make an excellent Vice President. Liz Parrelly and others agreed, Liz said that she would nominate Dawn, but at this time Dawn has respectfully declined (for now).

Coaches Corner Dinner on Sunday January 20th (was moved to George Murphy's) was an outstanding success. The event was attended by at least 60 people through the course of the day and Raffle sales raised \$746.00. Marc had not received a check from the proprietor as of yet for their donation.

Hall of Fame Dinner is March 13, 2019. Advanced tickets are \$35 each if purchased before March 1st, and \$40 each if purchased after March 1st. Liz is good to go. Menu will stay the same, and we will also have the snacks on the tables (as in the past). Dawn Nowak (future VP) has said that she will also help along with Lisa Hudy. The inductees are: the 2007-08 Girls' Golf Team, which went undefeated; Shannon Warner, who was a 2-time State Golf Champion and a Volleyball State Champion; and Coach John Filiatraut, who was a Varsity Football Coach and a throws coach for Varsity Track and Field. There is usually a team, an individual and a coach that is inducted each year.

The Golf Outing is June 9, 2019. Sandy Brown has agreed to Chair this year's event. Marc will need to get her the information on previous year's sponsors and attendee's. Annette Austin (not present) has agreed to help Sandy, as has Dawn Nowak and Liz Parrelly. Sandy is very anxious to get started stating that now is the time to solicit before budgets for these type of events are used up by local companies.

Lisa Hudy brought up the need for volunteer's to be a Judge for the CAP Scholarship Awards. Mark McConnell, Mary Beth Dunn, and Dawn Nowak volunteered. Sandy Brown also volunteered, but with her running the Golf Outing it was thought that it might be too much on her plate, if needed she thought that she could handle it. A total of 5 Judges are needed, so we will need to get a couple of other volunteers (the only prerequisite is that you don't have a senior that would be eligible applying for the Scholarship).
