C.A.P. Meeting Minutes from March 11, 2019

Meeting was called to order by President Mark McCusker at 7:00pm.

Treasurer Report: The balance as of March 11th is \$28,473.29. Monies came in from sales at the home basketball game, memberships and brick sales. \$198.00 was paid to Livonia Trophy for the Hall of Fame dinner. Mark McConnell motioned and Cathy seconded that the Treasurer Report be approved. The motion passed unanimously.

Meeting Minutes: The December minutes and February minutes were reviewed. Lisa H. motioned and Mary Beth Dunn seconded that the December minutes be approved. The motion passed unanimously. Lisa W. motioned and Mark McConnell seconded that the February minutes be approved. The motion passed unanimously.

Wish List: Marc asked for funds for new Division and Conference Championship banners in the gymnasium. This includes all of the sports at CHS, including the new ones. The total cost will be \$8970.00. Danielle asked about any surplus from the previous years' wish lists. In 2017-18, \$2600.00 was spent. In 2016-17, only \$1900.00 was spent. Mark McCusker mentioned the extra money that has been raised from the Rick Austin Memorial 5K Run. Tony motioned that \$3000.00 in CAP funds be used to help offset the cost to update all of the banners. Ed seconded. The motion passed unanimously. Marc thanked CAP for its continued support.

Athletic Program: Girls Basketball and Competitive Cheer were both City Champs. Cheer was also Division Champs and MHSAA Regional Qualifiers. Nate Sutton was an MHSAA State Qualifier for Boys Swim, broke the pool and school record, and was 11th in the State. Saydee Viau was a State Qualifier in Girls Gymnastics. Carly Dlugos and Noah Campbell were both State Qualifiers in Bowling. Noah also finished 11th in the State. Building improvements are still being completed. The outside work should finish this week. The gym floor and painting has been approved to start April 8th. It should take about three weeks. The new logo will be on the floor.

Committees:

Decals: Twenty-two decals were sold to the bowling team to make gifts for the banquet.

Membership: A few more memberships came through PayPal.
