C.A.P. Meeting Minutes from April 15, 2019

Meeting was called to order by President Mark McCusker at 7:01pm.

Treasurer Report: The balance as of April 13th is \$27,965.24. About \$350.00 was made in spirit wear. \$173.64 was transferred from PayPal from the Hall of Fame Dinner and memberships. One more check was sent for the Hall of Fame Dinner program printing. Seventy people attended the H of F Dinner and it broke even this year. Three checks cleared this month: \$1,751.36 for the Hall of Fame Dinner, \$115.00 to AIM for liability insurance and \$200.00 for the deposit for the golf outing. Checks were ordered for \$96.40. Dawn motioned and Shannon seconded that the Treasurer Report be approved. The motion passed unanimously.

Meeting Minutes: The March minutes were reviewed. Lisa H. motioned and Tony seconded that the minutes be approved. The motion passed unanimously.

Athletic Program: The updates on the facilities are 98% completed. The gym walls are done, floors will soon be completed. The banners will be done after the floor cures for ten days. Marc shared the invoice for the wall mounted banners for the competition gym. The total cost is \$8,970.00. Marc is also hoping to get new bleachers. They are original. In the meantime, the current bleachers will get new wheels. Tennis is hosting the Regional Meet to be held on May 17th. Softball is hosting a fundraising/awareness game with Stevenson on April 17th for organ donation. CHS coach Abe Vinitski has stage 4 kidney disease. Thursday, May 2nd at 2:30pm is signing day at Churchill. There are 20 athletes participating so far. Spring season is off to a great start so far.

Committees:

Decals: Bowling decals will need to be re-ordered. Mark McCusker will get pricing. Marc will find out about getting lacrosse decals.

Spirit wear: A re-order will be needed. 2XL and Small hoodies are completely out. Stadium seats will be given unassembled so people will be able to make sure the backs are on tight and correctly.

Old Business: Danielle updated that CAP scholarship applications have been copied and given to the judges. There are 26 applicants this year. This is about the average. All applicants have been verified to be current CAP members.

Nominations were taken for next year's executive board. Mark McCusker for President, Charisse Terry Elkins for Vice-President, Lisa Hudy for Treasurer and Danielle Dobar for Secretary. There will be one more chance to nominate someone at the meeting on May 13th. Voting will also take place at this meeting.

Charisse updated that the deposit has been made with Tin Cup. Dinner and golf will stay the same price as last year. \$85.00 for dinner and golf, \$35.00 for dinner only. Now is the time to get foursomes and donations. Annette Austin will be helping with donations. They need help with any donations that are NON-PERISHIBLE! Gift cards are great options. Sponsorships and donations can be made via PayPal. Sponsorship for a hole is \$150.00. The sponsor's name will be printed on a sign at the assigned hole. Need the sponsor information one week ahead of time to have signs ready. If a business sponsors a hole, get a business card to make sure the sign is made correctly. A person or family can also sponsor a hole "in honor of" or "in memory of". Swag bags are being assembled. They will go on all of the golf cards.
