## Scholarship – School Spirit – Character

C.A.P. Meeting Minutes from December 9, 2019

Meeting was called to order by President Mark McCusker at 7:00pm.

**Treasurer Report:** The balance as of December 8th is \$31,031.12. There is still one outstanding scholarship check for \$1000. Deposits were made for the 5K, membership and the 50<sup>th</sup> Celebration. Three checks were written: one for the 5K, \$500 for the Hall of Fame Dinner deposit (this is up from \$250 last year) and one to reimburse Lisa H. for the Go Daddy expenses. The Rick Austin Memorial 5K Run made \$6081.87. The budget for Athletic Wish List was increased from \$2500 to \$7500. Lisa W. motioned and Marc H. seconded that the Treasurer Report be approved. The motion passed unanimously.

**Meeting Minutes:** The minutes from the October meeting were reviewed. Dawn motioned and Kristin seconded that the October minutes be approved. The motion passed unanimously.

**Coaches' Wish List:** Paul Worley, the Boys Golf Team and Girls Golf Team coach, was unable to attend the CAP meeting but submitted a wish list item via Marc Hage. He would like to buy eight Titleist golf bags. They are regularly \$200 each, but he got a price of \$155 each. The golf teams will be doing a bottle drive fundraiser in the Spring to cover half of the cost. He is asking for \$620 to cover the other half of the cost. Mark McConnell motioned and Mary Beth seconded to give the golf teams \$620.00. The motion passed unanimously.

**Athletic Program:** We had five State Qualifiers for Girls Swim and Dive Team, one State Qualifier for Girls Golf. Volleyball won the Regional title. Football made it to the quarterfinals and Girls Cross Country won the Division title. Winter sports have started. The bowling team won their first invite. We will be getting new banners for the gym and the floor will be re-sanded in the summer.

### Committees:

**Spirit Wear:** They will be selling spirit wear at the basketball game vs. Franklin on 2/7. Other sale dates will be the Incoming Freshman Night on January 21<sup>st</sup> and possibly the hockey game against Franklin.

**Bricks:** Ed Holton said he will have bricks done in the next two weeks.

**Old Business:**

**Rick Austin Memorial 5K Run:** There were 163 people signed up for the 5K, with 132 finishers. There were 31 online student registrations, 124 online adult registrations and 8 walk-ins. This is comparable to last year.

**New Business:**

**Hall of Fame Dinner:** The date for the Hall of Fame Dinner is March 18, 2020. It will be at the Italian American Club this year, but they are looking into the Hellenic Center for next year. This year's inductees are: 2016 graduate, 12 Varsity letter winner, Jon Hovermale; Jim Solak, the Basketball Coach from 2000-2015; and John Knittel, a 1986 graduate that played Football, Basketball and Track & Field.

**Coaches Corner Dinner:** The Coaches Corner Dinner will be at 2pm on 1/19/20. There will be 50/50 sold and the dinner is always a fun time! Dawn can help sell 50/50.

**Scholarship:** The deadline for this year's scholarship applications is April 1, 2020. This year's judging will consist of confirming the athletes' applications and verifying the points earned, and the judges will score the essay portion of the application.

Mark McConnel motioned and Kristin seconded that the meeting be adjourned. The meeting was adjourned at 7:56.
