C.A.P. Meeting Minutes from February 10, 2020

Treasurer Report: The balance as of February 8th is \$32,476.90. The balance in PayPal is \$924.00 from memberships, one stadium seat and the Hall of Fame dinner. The Coaches' Corner dinner earned \$814.00 from 50/50 sales and they also gave us a check for \$500.00. \$210.00 in spirit wear was sold at Incoming Freshman Night and \$190.00 at the basketball game. We have spent \$200.00 for the golf outing deposit, \$115.00 for insurance and a check for a \$45.00 reimbursement for a stadium seat. Lisa W. motioned and Kristin seconded that the Treasurer Report be approved. The motion passed unanimously.

Meeting Minutes: The minutes from the January meeting were not available to review. We will review January and February's minutes at the March meeting.

Coaches' Wish List: Golf bags were purchased, and Marc has the invoice. \$620.00 was approved and CAP will reimburse.

Lawrence Scheffer introduced himself. He is the new baseball coach.

Athletic Program: We are $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way through Winter Season. Almost all the teams are in the top half of the division. For the Observerland Meet, CHS placed 6th out of 23 teams. We hosted a cheer competition and State playoffs are coming up. March 9th is the start of Spring Season. April is the last student leadership conference for the year. They are going well.

The new Lakes Valley Conference asked if the Livonia high schools would like to join their conference. They are the three Walled Lake schools, two South Lyon schools, two Waterford schools and the two Huron Valley schools. LPS did not feel at this time that it would be a good fit due to the travel distances.
